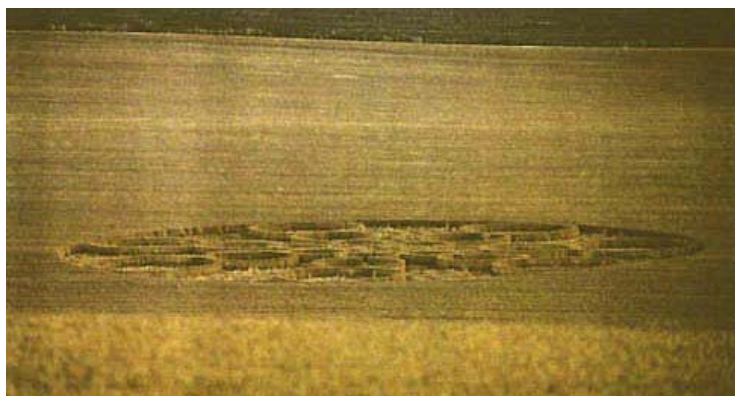


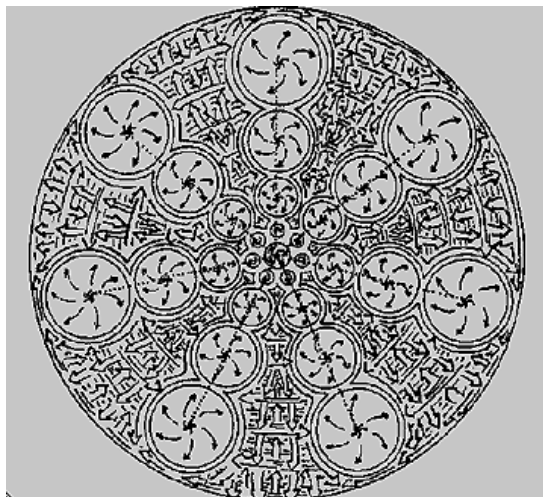

**September 19, 1999 Bishops Cannings, Wiltshire, England** Andreas Mueller, a student from Saarbruecken, Germany, and his colleague from Switzerland, Werner Anderhub, took the only ground photographs of the remarkable "Basket" formation before the farmer destroyed it with his harvester on August 6th at Bishop Cannings near Devizes and Roundway Hill .
