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Two Bulls and Several Cows Dead and Mutilated in Manitoba, Canada

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"I've had dead animals before, but I've never seen them like this.

And then Greg (Wotowich) lost his bull and just recently, Lois and Steve Matis lost one of their cows. The teats on theirs was cut off in circles just like mine."

August 17, 2007 Komarno and Gimli, Manitoba, Canada - The modern era of worldwide animal mutilations goes back to the 1960s. Canada had as many reports as the United States. For example, in August 1967, exactly forty years ago, on the Sarcee Reserve near Twin Bridges in Alberta, a dead horse was found where a witness claimed a "domed saucer craft" had been seen earlier that day.

Then three months later in early November 1967, two horses were found dead near Livingston, Ontario. One had a long, bloodless cut on its neck. The other had its throat and jugular vein cut off, yet there was no evidence of blood. That was November 6, 1967. The day before, near Livingston, a resident reported seeing a large UFO.

Since then, literally thousands of animals – including wild game and all kinds of domestic stock – have been found with a similar pattern of bloodless excisions: an ear is cut off close to the scalp. On the same side of the head, an eye is often removed along with a circular excision of hide around the eye. Half the jaw flesh is cut out along with the entire tongue from deep within the throat. In almost all cases, genitals are excised in neat oval or circular hide-deep patterns and often the rectum and/or vaginal tissue is cored out as well. All without blood or signs of struggle.

7 Cows, 2 Calves and 1 Bull Die Mysteriously in Komarno, Manitoba



Gimli, Manitoba, Canada (pink circle) is about 50 miles north of Winnipeg and has a population of 6,000. A couple miles away, 125 residents live in the small farm town of Komarno, which means "mosquito" in Ukrainian.

And now come more cattle mutilation reports in the province of Manitoba between July 8 and August 9. Sheila Vigfusson has lived and farmed in Komarno the past twelve years. She runs a herd of 300 cattle, about half male and half female. Komarno is a very small rural community only a couple of miles from Gimli, which has a population of about 6,000. Both towns are near Lake Winnipeg north of Winnipeg, Manitoba. And this summer, both towns are now on the animal mutilation map.

On July 8, Sheila found five of her adult cows and two calves dead with odd, bloodless excisions of hide and circular excisions of teats from the udders. Her vet came out to get tissue samples to send to a Canadian lab testing for anthrax. That dreaded disease had suddenly appeared in Komarno and Gimli, much to the shock of farmers and ranchers who had never had to deal with anthrax before.

The next day, on July 9, Sheila found another dead cow. Then two days after that on July 11, she found another cow and one of her bulls mutilated. None had any blood on or around them. Most had the odd circular excisions of hide from their bloated bodies. Sheila was very confused and troubled because anthrax causes animals to bleed.

When she got the tissue test results back, none of her animals had tested positive for anthrax, but she still had a total of 10 dead animals, cause of death unknown, and an 11th missing that never turned up. Sheila told me, "Now I wish I had taken photographs, but I was so upset and so confused about what was happening that I didn't even want to look at my dead animals."

Sheila Vigfusson, Rancher, Komarno, Manitoba, Canada: "It's just so weird to me. What gets me is that I have ten animals dead and I don't know what they died from. And I've never seen this (dead animals) with no blood. We've been farming a long time and have quite a lot of cattle. I've had dead animals before, but I've never seen them like this, you know? And then Greg (Wotowich) lost his bull and just recently, Lois and Steve Matis lost one of their cows. The teats on theirs was cut off in circles just like mine."

A 2,700-Pound-Bull Is Mutilated in Gimli, Manitoba

Two and a half weeks later on July 29, only a couple of miles down the road from Sheila's place, Greg Woytowich was working on Sunday afternoon, July 29, around 3:30 PM. Greg is 42-years-old and has farmed in Gimli the past eleven years. One of his prize purchases two years ago was a 10-year-old pedigreed black Angus bull from Scotland. That bull weighed 2,700 pounds and was the best bull Greg had ever owned.

That hot, sunny day, Greg and his brother were bailing hay. Greg had just started making his first found of the pasture when he was perplexed about what he was seeing sticking up from pasture grass about two hundred feet away.

Greg Woytowich, Farmer and Mechanic for the Province of Manitoba Natural Resources Department, Gimli, Manitoba, Canada: "I made the corner with the tractor and bailer and I looked over to my right. I seen a leg sticking up out of the tall grass and a raven flew up.

So, I stopped the tractor and went over the fence and walked out approximately 60 yards from the fence and there was my bull lying on the ground. His head was facing north and his legs were facing east. I walked up to (his back) and figured, 'Oh, crap!' because we had anthrax break out in the area. So I left (without looking at bull closely) and phoned the veterinarian to come out and take samples from him. And I was cheesed off! (laughs) But I figured there was no use standing around. The bull's dead, so I got back in the tractor and continued to bail.

It was about 90 minutes from the time I discovered the bull until the vet showed up that Sunday. Then, we returned back to where the bull was and now I noticed he was missing his skin on his abdomen and his scrotum was cut out and I noticed his ear and tongue were gone.

I said to the vet, 'You know, this is kind of weird. What's with this?'

He looked and just said, 'Oh, it's just wildlife. Animals were getting at him.' He took a sample from the neck (depression on neck in top photo) as a tissue sample and that was it.

I asked, 'Can I bury him?'

He said, 'No, we have to send the test in, so he's not going anywhere – just leave him there.'

I found that odd if it's a suspicion of anthrax. There's certain things you have to do with anthrax-infected animals. But that was it. I was cheesed off, my bull was dead, he took the samples, I closed the gate and carried on.

In the meantime, since it was a Sunday, I talked to another vet I have used and usually deal with. And he contacted me Monday morning and asked what had happened. I told him and said this Dr. Katreece (first vet on Sunday) had come out and taken samples. Now, this vet on Monday told me I should get in contact with Dr. Megan Bergman, in charge of the anthrax outbreak with Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFI).

So I contacted her and she asked, 'Have you covered him with a tarp?' She said, 'Do that as soon as possible. Why cover with the tarp is because if it is anthrax, you basically cook the anthrax (spores) under the tarp in the hot weather we were having and it kills the spores.

Greg Realizes Missing Tissue from Bull Was Cut with Sharp Instrument

So, I went back to the pasture on the afternoon of Monday (July 30, 2007), and I took a tarp and I covered him. But as I pulled the tarp over, I started looking more closely and got a really good look at the front of him and thought, 'There is something wrong here!' So, I phoned the vet back and said, 'I was tarping him to cover him up and those are not wildlife wounds or whatever you want to call them.' I've butchered my own animals for beef and I've been skinning steers since I was 8-years-old. There's a way that hide is taken away and you can tell it's been skinned.

So I was telling the vet this and basically he gave me a blast back. He said, 'No one has touched that animal. Wildlife did that and on and on and on.

I said, 'OK, fine!' But I went to work – I work for Natural Resources for Province of Manitoba – and my district supervisor, he's been a game warden for 30 years. And I was telling him about this. And he said he had heard something not too long ago in Riverton where a rancher lost a bull that was mutilated.

So, Irwin says to me, 'Come on. I'll bring my camera and let's go take a look.'

So we went out to the bull and uncovered him and Irwin is looking and says, 'Geez, you know' – he's been all over the place and a game warden for 30 years. He said, 'I've seen caribou, I've seen moose – I've seen everything eaten from wildlife. And there's no bloody way in the world that that's wildlife.'

So he said, 'If I were you, I would get hold of the RCMP.' (Royal Canadian Mounted Police)

So, I phoned the RCMP – this was a couple of days after – and they did not sound surprised or shocked. They didn't call me an idiot over the phone by no means. They were just interested in the location of the animal. They wanted to go take pictures to compare them with some other photos that they had.

THAT WERE ALSO CURRENT NOW?

Yeah. Or with what they have on file. I'm not sure. But they went out and when they pulled the tarp off, the bull was white and crawling with maggots and like typical cops, they just put the tarp back over him. But they requested that I give them copies of my photographs. So, I went and did that. The bull was lying out there and the tests came back negative.

IT CAME BACK NEGATIVE FOR ANTHRAX?

Right, the first tests were negative, but Dr. Bergman's reason was the state of decay that the bull was in - that they could not get an accurate test. They had to send it to a better lab. So she went and sent the samples to another lab.

In the meantime, the authorities came out. I had the hole dug already and we treated it as a positive anthrax case. They never even took the tarp off of him. They just sprayed everything down with disinfectant and I pushed him in the hole and buried him.

Now, I had my photos and that's when I went to show them to Sheila because I heard she had lost a bunch of cows. She was actually just finishing burying some.

She said, 'I thought I was crazy. Some of mine were cut. One was missing a tongue, one was missing an ear, and the teats were cut off.' But she said, 'I didn't want to say nothing because everyone is going to say I'm looney, eh!'

I said, 'No. Look at my pictures. This isn't wildlife. There's no way in hell!'

A week later she came and got my pictures and emailed them to you to get your opinion.

IT'S A CLASSIC ANIMAL MUTILATION."

Over my years of animal mutilation investigations, some of the more puzzling details are bloodless puncture holes or gouges in the hide. Gregg Woytowich's bull had a deep gouge in the armpit of his left front leg.

Greg Woytowich: "Yeah, I seen that. In this photo, I was poking in there with a stick. I was seeing how deep it was.

HOW DEEP DID THE STICK GO?

Probably three inches.

THOSE KINDS OF DETAILS HAVE BEEN FOUND ON BODIES IN WHICH WHEN NECROPSIES WERE DONE, THE HEART HAS BEEN FOUND COMPLETELY MISSING FROM INSIDE THE PERICARDIUM WITHOUT ANY CUTS OR TEARS IN THE PERICARDIUM. THAT IS WORK WITH A TECHNOLOGY WE HUMANS DO NOT HAVE.

Exactly. I was laughing seeing these pictures and I said, 'Who knows, maybe aliens!' (laughs)

THAT'S WHAT GOVERNMENT PEOPLE TELL ME IT IS.

And people look at me kind of funny and start laughing and I say, 'If you think we are the only ones that walk on a planet in this universe, you're very naive.'

WHAT I'M TRYING TO UNDERSTAND IS: OUR GOVERNMENT APPARENTLY LINKS GLOBAL ANIMAL MUTILATIONS AND WHAT HAPPENED TO YOUR BULL IN THEIR OWN DOCUMENTS, THEY CALL THEM 'EXTRATERRESTRIAL BIOLOGICAL ENTITIES.' THE QUESTION IS: WHY? WHAT IS THIS HUGE HARVEST OF MATERIAL FROM ALL THESE ANIMALS AROUND THE WORLD THAT'S BEEN GOING ON FOR AT LEAST A CENTURY – WHY?

Yeah, and you know when I was talking with a constable at the RCMP, He said, 'I don't know what it is, but these animal mutilations in this area (of Manitoba) say within 100 square miles, there are always reports at this time of year.'

AND FROM YOUR BULL, WHAT YOU KNOW WAS CUT OUT WAS THE RIGHT EAR DOWN TO ITS BASE. THE TONGUE WAS GONE. THE BELLY TISSUE THAT WOULD HAVE SURROUNDED THE EXIT OF HIS PENIS AND TESTICLES WAS REMOVED IN A VERY LARGE OVAL.

AND A SECOND HOLE WAS MADE INTO THE BACK ABDOMEN AREA WHERE THE INTERNAL PENILE TISSUE IS FALLING OUT OF THE ANIMAL.

Yeah.

THE RECTUM WAS INTACT?

Yes and untouched.

GREG, WHAT DO YOU THINK ABOUT WHY ANTHRAX SHOULD SUDDENLY SHOW UP IN YOUR AREA WHERE THERE ARE ANIMAL MUTILATIONS AT THE SAME TIME?

Right, this is a weird, weird situation. As I said, I'm a fourth generation farmer. We've had cattle all along. I've never, ever in this area – I would say within 100 square miles – we've never had anthrax.

WHY NOW?

Yeah, and why now?

LOIS SAID THE SAME THING. SHE ALSO SAID THAT AUTHORITIES ARE TRYING TO BLAME THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HYDRO ELECTRIC LINE AND THAT STIRRED UP THE SOIL?

Yeah, well, that's bullshit! (laughs) First of all, they did not disturb the soil. All they did was go through there with a hydro ax and just mowed the bush down. They never touched the ground.

Non-Human Mutilation Perpetrators?

IF NON-HUMANS WERE THE ONES INVOLVED IN THE MANITOBA ANIMAL DEATHS IN THE LAST FOUR WEEKS, WOULD THEY BE THERE BECAUSE ANTHRAX IS SUDDENLY FLOURISHING AND THE ALIENS ARE MONITORING SOMETHING? THESE ARE THE MYSTERIES. WHY THE FOCUS IN EXACTLY THE

SPOT WHERE ANTHRAX HAS BROKEN OUT, BUT YOU HAVE NEVER SEEN BEFORE?

I am very open minded about that. As I said, if people think we're the only living creatures in this universe, they are very naive and sadly mistaken.

RIGHT, AND WHEN YOU THINK ABOUT THAT – THAT NON-HUMANS ARE INVOLVED WITH THE GLOBAL HARVESTING OF GENETIC MATERIAL, FLUIDS AND ALL OF THAT, FROM ANIMALS AROUND THE WORLD - INCLUDING HORSES, CATTLE, GOATS, SHEEP, WILD GAME – WHAT ARE YOU LEFT WITH AS A RESIDUE IN YOUR OWN THOUGHTS ABOUT THAT?

Maybe they have an agenda they are following, too, just like anyone else, like I'm the cattle farmer and that's my agenda. If there is someone from other planets flying around and need this (from animals), heck – all you have to do is stop and ask. (laughs) I'm sure we could work something out!

GREG, I COMPLETELY AGREE WITH YOUR ATTITUDE AND IT HAS ALWAYS PUZZLED ME ABOUT WHY OUR ELECTED OFFICIALS TAKE THE HARD HANDED APPROACH THAT THE PUBLIC AND MEDIA WILL PANIC IF WE LEARN WHAT THEY KNOW. I THINK THAT IS UNDERMINING OUR ABILITY TO BE VOTING PUBLICS WITH GOVERNMENTS THAT WE TRUST. NOBODY TRUSTS THE GOVERNMENTS NOW BECAUSE EVERY GOVERNMENT IS LYING TO US.

Oh, I know! It doesn't matter if you're the United States or Canada or Paraguay or who the hell ever! It's all the same crap.

IF GOVERNMENTS DID LEVEL WITH EVERYONE AND THERE WAS SOME WAY TO NEGOTIATE WITH SOME HUMANS: 'OK, YOU NEED X ANIMALS. WELL, WE HAVE TO PAY OUR FARMERS. SO, YOU DO THIS FOR US IN A TRADE DEAL.

Right. You know what gets me? We have slaughtering plants. Instead of mutilating out in the pastures, you could put one of your own (alien) people there (in the slaughter house) and as they go down the line, they could sample this, that and other things.

RIGHT!

Here you go, take it. But don't kill my bull out in the pasture! (laughs)

YOU ARE MAKING AN EXCELLENT POINT. AND ALL THE SECRECY AND COVER-UP INTERFERES WITH WHAT COULD BE A REASONABLE AND LOGICAL APPROACH TO THEIR ALIEN NEEDS, OUR NEEDS, AND IT COULD BE A WIN/WIN INSTEAD OF THE SCARY, DESTRUCTIVE SECRECY.

Yeah, exactly. And if they (aliens) have the technology to come and visit us whenever they want, I could probably assume they could wipe out humankind with the flick of a button.

THE FACT THAT THEY DON'T MEANS THAT IS NOT WHAT THEY WANT.

That's right."

August 9, 2007 - Another Cow Mutilation in Kimarno On the Lois and Steve Matis Farm

The same day that Greg Woytowich found his prize bull dead, one of his cows gave birth to a male calf sired by that mutilated bull. So, now Greg is going to watch the new calf grow up, hoping he will match his father's physical greatness - and not be selected as another prime mutilation specimen.

Greg told me that only four miles down the road from his farm back in Komarno, Lois and Steve Matis also lost a cow to the strange bloodless excisions. Lois confirmed that on the morning of August 9, 2007, she found one of her best 9-year-old cows dead and mutilated - a cow she had seen alive in the early evening the night before.

Lois Matis, Farmer, Komarno, Manitoba, Canada: "Her ear was missing and all four teats were missing. When we got looking closer, the ear was definitely cut. You could see the mark where when you cut into the hide, the white part inside the hide, you could see it very visibly. The two teats that were on the top, definitely looked cut. The bottom two – it's hard to say.

I agree. The top two have the circular excisions seen in other mutilations. The bottom two could be predator. It's confusing.

The Canadian Food Inspectors (CFI) came out to spray with an anthrax spore poison on our dead cow.

DID THEY COMMENT ABOUT THE STRANGE EXCISIONS OF THE EAR AND TEATS?

They asked if someone had come and taken samples because CFI does cut an ear off for tests. We said that nobody had been there. My husband, Steve, said to him, 'Doesn't it look like these were cut off?' The CFI guy answered, 'Yeah, I kind of thought so, but I
